Statement of Eastern Partnership Civil Society Forum Georgian National Platform

Eastern Partnership Georgian Civil Society National Platform supports the joint initiative of non-governmental and media organizations on resuming the "This Affects You" campaign.

We think the problem related to surveillance is still high on the agenda and creating system guarantees is necessary in order to exclude the willfulness of law-enforcement bodies on the matter.

We agree with the initiators of the campaign that the certain provisions of applicable Georgian legislation run counter to the standards established by the European Court of Human Rights.

We ask the parliament to share the following proposals developed by the initiators of the "This Affects You" campaign:

- To create effective system, which will ensure the high standards of investigating the violation of law on one hand, and exclude the possibility of obtaining personal information on private citizens arbitrarily and groundlessly;
- To exercise surveillance and interception only in case of concrete persons and crime (namely, in case of grave and especially grave crimes);
- To set time limits on surveillance and interception in order to exclude that they are used arbitrarily and with excessive time periods; also, introduce effective regulations of keeping and destroying surveillance and interception tapes;
- To create an independent mechanism to supervise surveillance and interception, and increase responsibilities of the Court and other responsible bodies.
- To increase the role of the Court and the Parliament.
