

## <u>EaP CSF Georgian National Platform Statement</u> <u>regarding the Orlando, Florida, Shooting in June 12, 2016</u>

The Eastern Partnership Civic Society Forum Georgian National Platform, would like to express our deepest sympathy and support for the victims and their families of the Orlando mass shooting 2016, June 12. We grieve for the families that have been affected.

This outrageous attack on innocent citizens is not just on the LGBTQ community in Florida, but is an attack on all humanity and the universal values that we share.

America was founded on the idea that each person is entitled to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer (LGBTQ) rights in the United States have evolved and progressed over time, as demonstrated in the U.S. Supreme Court rulings in Lawrence v. Civil rights for LGBTQ people in the United States are advocated by a variety of organizations. That is why the worst mass shooting in the U.S. history was so unexpected.
