Thank you for your letter of 7 December 2023, addressed to President von der Leyen and to me, and sharing the joint declaration of the EU-Georgia Civil Society Platform (CSP).

Civil society's active, inclusive and meaningful participation in the policymaking process is critical for advancing Georgia on its reform path towards future EU membership, especially in the areas of rule of law and fundamental rights.

We look forward to our future engagement with you and the EU-Georgia Civil Society Platform. Joint actions remain crucial in building more inclusive, democratic, and prosperous communities in Georgia and across the region. Georgia's advancement on its European path will greatly benefit both Georgia and the EU.
